


### Make 2024 your year!

# Fired up for Annual Charity Golf Day

This year we're celebrating 28 years of teeing off with the Queensland Fire and Emergency Service at our annual Fires Charity Golf Day.

First taking to the golf course in 1996, this much-loved event has raised an incredible \$154,048.49 in support of funding life-saving equipment for the Toowoomba Hospital Emergency Department.

The very first donation made to Toowoomba Hospital from funds raised at the first golf day helped to fund a new patient transfer trolley valued at \$3,500 in 1997. With the most recent items purchased including a patient transfer scale, a jaundice meter, and a tono-pen totaling nearly \$20,000.

The Firies dedication over the years has made the Firies Charity Golf Day our longest running event – here's to another 28 years of hole-in-one fundraising for the Emergency Department!

In May, we celebrate all things volunteering and shine the spotlight on our vollies during National Volunteers Week from the 20-26 May.



With over 3,000 items in our Museum of Health collection, we're excited to bring the rich stories of our region's history of medicine and healthcare to life.

Dating from the late 19<sup>th</sup> century to the early 21<sup>st</sup> century, the Toowoomba Hospital and Baillie Henderson Hospital collections represent the evolution of healthcare and mental healthcare in Queensland.

The objects, photographs, memory and lived experiences of patients and staff across communities and time have now been curated, cared for, and stored for future generations. With a selection of artefacts on display for Toowoomba, the Darling Downs, and Australia to experience and reflect in the historic Medical Superintendent's House along Hogg Street in the grounds of Baillie Henderson Hospital.
